**I. BOARD MEETING DATE FOR APPROVAL OF THE MBSD PROPOSED FINAL OPERATING BUDGET FOR 2026-2027**

Recommend the Board advertise the June 2026 Regular Meeting date as Monday, June 15, 2026 at 6:30 pm when the 2026-2027 Midland Borough School District final operating budget will be approved. The date will satisfy the required 30-day availability for public review.

**II. EDUCATION – Ms. Cheryl Williams, *Chairperson***

Recommend the Board approve the Agreement with Adelphoi Education, Inc. to provide private academic programs for Midland School District students for the 2026-2027 academic year. The daily rate for emotional support services per pupil is \$172.10.

Recommend the Board approve the Resolution of the Midland Borough School District approving the revival of the Beaver County Vocational Technical School authority and authorizing and approving the filing of a Municipal Statement of Revival.

Recommend the Letter of Agreement with the BVIU 27 to provide Title I Nonpublic Programs and Services for District students beginning July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2027. The Agreement reflects a rate of \$116.40 per student hour for Title I instructional services for District private school children.

**III. FINANCE – Mr. Anthony D’Itri, *Chairperson***

Recommend the Board approve the Proposed Final Budget in its most recent form for the Midland Borough School District for the 2026-2027 fiscal year in the amount of \$6,558,230.00. The budget represents a 2% decrease from the 2025-2026 budget and zero mill increase of local taxes. The Proposed Final Budget is expected to be presented as a Final Budget at a school board meeting held at 6:30 pm on June 15, 2026. The Proposed Final Budget will be available on the District website at [www.midlandpa.org](http://www.midlandpa.org) for public review for 30 days. If an individual is unable to access the Proposed Final Budget on the District website a printed copy may be obtained by contacting Ms. Kelley Schulte at [kelley.schulte@midlandpa.org](mailto:kelley.schulte@midlandpa.org). The budget may be amended before or after final adoption.

Recommend the Board approve the MOU with the Midland Borough School District and Allegheny Intermediate Unit to participate in the Title III AIU Consortium grant initiatives and compliance procedures.

**IV. PERSONNEL – Ms. Samantha Byrd, *Chairperson***

Recommend the Board approve hiring Mr. William Scabilloni in the position of teaching assistant for the District for the remainder of the 2025-2026 academic year. Mr. Scabilloni will be covering for faculty absences and leaves. The daily rate is \$150 and there are no healthcare benefits included with this position.

Recommend the Board approve hiring Joseph D’Itri and Maddox Tanner as summer interns to assist with custodial, groundskeeping, and general office duties. The pay rate is \$15 per hour for the summer intern position.

**V. PROPERTY – Mr. Daniel Doyle, *Chairperson***

Recommend the Board approve the request from Ms. Christine Albaugh, Executive Director of Circle of Friends, Inc. Senior Services, to utilize the Midland Gymnasium on July 17, 2026, from 9:00 am – 2:30 pm to distribute Beaver County farmer’s market vouchers. The vouchers are available to eligible senior recipients and can be redeemed for Pennsylvania fresh fruits, vegetable, and edible herbs and can be used at over 1,029 SFMNP participating farmers markets in PA.
